Dear Student:

Welcome back to Spring Semester. We are writing to you about Upperclass Honors Housing for 2008-2009. Applicants are selected based on semesters on campus, number of Honors courses completed, and g.p.a. Students enrolled in the Honors Program will receive priority for spaces; however we anticipate spaces for other eligible students, so we encourage those students to apply as well. In general, a 3.0 g.p.a. or higher is required, but some spaces may be available if your g.p.a. is less than 3.0.

Students enrolled in the Honors Program with a 3.0 g.p.a. or above are guaranteed a space in Upperclass Honors Housing. (This guarantee applies to Upperclass Honors Housing only, not to other areas of campus.) We encourage other interested students to apply and anticipate that spaces will be available, including those honors students who wish to live with a non-honors roommate. We cannot guarantee an upperclass Honors floor for non-Honors students. These floors which will house upperclass students only are:

Sypherd is air-conditioned and accessible to students with disabilities. Sharp is air-conditioned but not accessible. If you need air-conditioning, you must request Sypherd or Sharp. Air-conditioning is only guaranteed for students with an ADA-qualified need. See the Sign Up brochure for details about providing medical documentation.

All floors will be characterized by residents' commitment to individual academic achievement and participation in extracurricular programs.

Students applying to upperclass honors floors are not required to submit a supplemental application. You can do everything on the Web. Just apply for Upperclass Honors Housing on the application form and follow the instructions on the preference form. Students already living in Upperclass Honors Housing will be able to return to their rooms/buildings, as long as they have a minimum 3.0 g.p.a. and select the Return Request option on the preference form. If students are requesting to return with a roommate who doesn't qualify for Honors housing, this option is not guaranteed.

The deadline for submitting all Housing applications is Saturday, March 15th. This is also the deadline to submit your \$200 deposit.

If you would like to discuss this option, or obtain additional information, please stop by the Housing Office or plan to attend the Housing Fair in the Trabant University Center on Tuesday, February 26th from 11:00 a.m. — 4:00 p.m. A timetable of the application process follows.

Deadline to submit \$200 deposit.

Deadline to cancel housing application and receive a 50% refund of housing deposit.

Friday, April 25th (tentative)

All assignments released. Assignments will be posted on the WEB. Information emailed to students not able to be placed initially in Upperclass Honors Housing.

Friday, May 30th

Deadline to submit room change forms if desired.

Saturday, May 31st

Deadline to cancel housing application/agreement before binding date.

Sunday, June 1st

All students with active housing applications/assignments are bound to the housing agreement for the 2008-2009 academic year.
