A Freshman Fellow is an Honors freshman* living in Russell Complex, who is familiar with the Honors Program, and has a strong commitment to help other students benefit from an Honors education. The Freshman Fellow position is a volunteer position. Freshman Fellows are involved with helping the Honors Program in a variety of ways. The responsibilities of a Freshman Fellow are as follows:

1. Knowing and assisting students in the Russell Complex by:
 - Visiting with students on the floors and being available to them to answer any questions.
 - Being aware of resources and programs offered through the Honors Program and referring students to the Honors Program office when appropriate.
2. Promoting and encouraging activities among Russell Complex students by:
 - In conjunction with Russell Fellows, planning a variety of social and cultural programs for students (including the Russell Coffeehouse). Freshman Fellows are expected to shadow an end of the semester RF Program and organize one program in the spring, preferably an on campus program.
 - Encouraging Residents to attend Fellows and Residence Life Programs
3. Serving as representatives of the Honors Program by:
 - Demonstrating strong leadership skills and being role models on their floors.
4. Preparing oneself with information and skills necessary for the job by:
 - Attending all Russell and Freshman Fellow meetings.
 - Taking an active part in all orientation sessions.
 - Regularly attending floor meetings with the Russell Fellows to relay information to students.

Position Benefits:

- Leadership training and a leadership role on the floor.
- Freshman Fellow T-shirt.
